To build on this energy, we are proud to launch our **Adopt an Oakland School** program.

HOW DO I ADOPT AN OAKLAND SCHOOL?

When you Adopt an Oakland School, you will be **paired with an Oakland public school** where members of your team will build a lasting connection with students and staff (minimum one-year commitment). by taking part in **at least three** of these volunteer opportunities:

Back to	 Help ready campus for the first day of school (August 17, 18, or 19).
School	Collect and deliver school supplies to ensure all scholars have the tools they need
	to succeed.
Read Ins	Read to students at the school during our three annual Read-Ins (October, February,
	and May).
Career Day	Organize a "shadow day" or career day.
Teacher	Host a Teacher Appreciation Celebration at the school during Thank a Teacher
Appreciation	Month (May).
Special Event	Run a clean-up day or other customized volunteer event at any time during the
	school year.

Your organization will also **donate \$5,000** to the Ed Fund to help coordinate these volunteer activities so they have the greatest impact.

By adopting your school, you will be a consistent, positive presence at the school and make a real difference for its students. At the end of the year, the Ed Fund will produce a photo-heavy report highlighting the impact of your volunteer efforts at the school.
